There are significant differences in plumage between juvenile and adult birds - see illustrations; Post-juvenile moult is thought to result in adult plumage;

Sexing :

Not sexually dimorphic on size and claimed plumage differences (by aviculturists) are unreliable for sexing birds in the field – some claim that males are brighter than females; males have more silvergrey crown and nape than females; under tail coverts and thighs are black in males and rust-brown in females and a wider, straighter breast band in males than females; Both sexes incubate.
