
Shining Bronze-Cuckoo Chrysococcyx lucidus Species No.: 344 Band size: 03



Morphometrics:

The measurements presented here are for the subspecies *C.I. plagosus* which breeds in eastern and south-western Australia. The nominate *C.I lucidus* breeds in NZ and nearby islands and occurs on mainland eastern Australia only as a non-breeding season passage migrant as it migrates to overwinter on the islands north of Australia.

Sexing:

Not size dimorphic; but several plumage characters separates the sexes;

The back of the female is brownish-green glossy bronze whereas the male is more iridescent green-bronze;

Orbital ring is different - see above under Ageing;

Adult (2+)

The underside of the outer tail feathers are also fairly definitive with the female having rufous spots on t4 and some rufous, or buff, colouring on t3 & t5. No rufous on males (see illustrations above); Barring on the lower chest and abdomen of females is narrower that on males.
