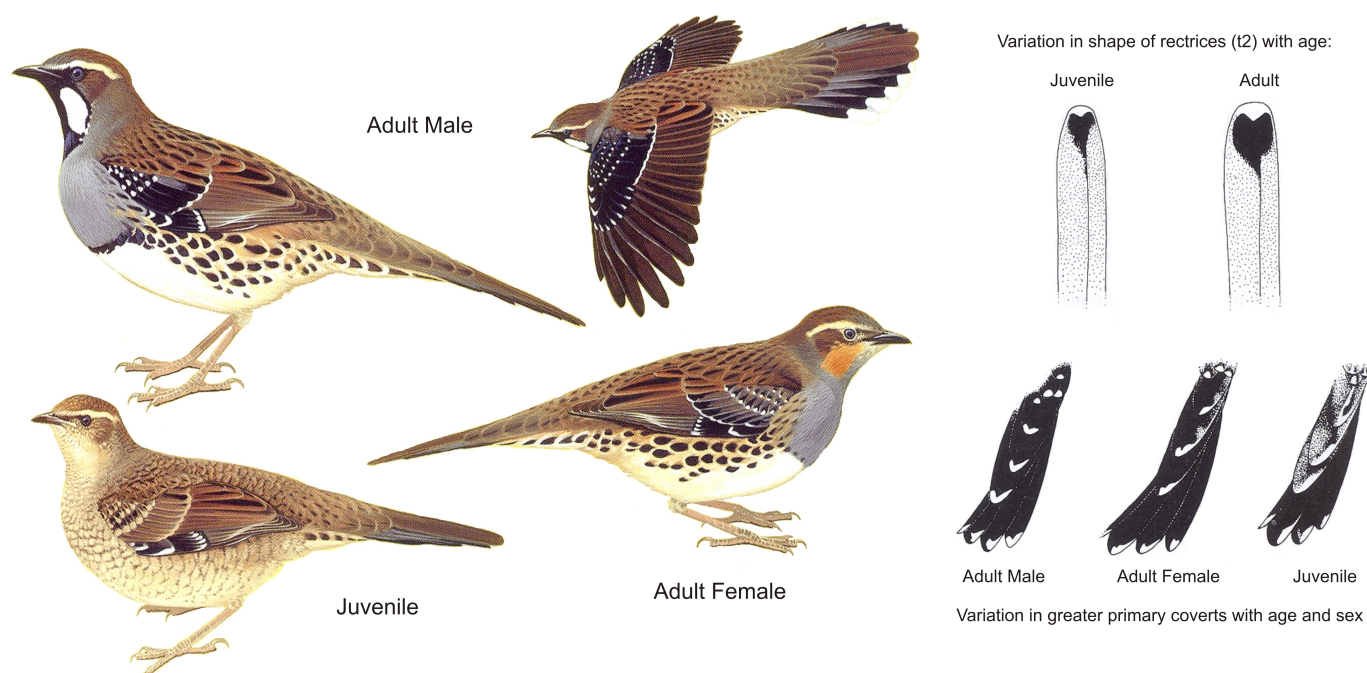


Spotted Quail-thrush *Cinclosoma punctatum* Species No.: 436 Band size: 06



Morphometrics:

Measurements given below are for the nominate *C.c. punctatum* of s-e Queensland, eastern NSW, Victoria and s-e SA. The other two subspecies *C.c. anachoreta* of the Mt. Lofty Ranges, SA and *C.c. dovei* of Tasmania may be a slightly smaller, but there is a dearth of information to confirm.

Ageing:

The drawings above illustrate plumage differences between adults and juveniles; Immatures are very similar to adults and retain juvenile remiges, rectrices, some coverts and alula; Synchronous growth bars in wing and tail are obvious indicators of retained juvenile feathers.

Sexing:

Adults differ in plumage and size with males larger than females;
Juveniles are not plumage dimorphic;
Female only incubates.
