NEW SOUTH WALES ALBATROSS STUDY GROUP.

Members will by now have seen Doug Gibson's "Third Report of the N.S.W. Albatross Study Group" which appears in the latest issue (Vol. 63, Part 3) of The Emu. This brings the story up to the end of 1962, and a truly dramatic story it is, with the firm evidence that these great birds which feed off the New South Wales coast each winter gather from all corners of the Southern Ocean. The regular interchange of banded birds between observers at two points on opposite sides of the world, here described, must be unique in the annals of bird banding. A report on the progress at Malabar in the 1963 season appeared in our last issue. To bring the story right up-to-date we now have a note from Gibson on the (rather disappointing) results at Bellambi during the past season and a final postscript from Malabar.
