





REVIEWS

A Handlist of the Birds of Victoria, by W. Roy Wheeler. Victorian Ornithological Research Group, 1967, 88 pp. Price: \$2.75.

The publication of this status and distribution list of all birds known to have been recorded from Victoria, at about the same time as Storr's List of Northern Territory Birds, completes recently summarised knowledge of avian distribution for every State except Queensland. A detailed list of the birds of that one remaining State, which possesses more species than any of the others, would be most welcome. It would then be reasonably easy to compile comprehensive distribution data for a new Australian Checklist.

The author of this Handlist has been very active in Victorian ornithology for many years and has gathered a tremendous amount of information. The whole has been carefully arranged and presented in very readable fashion. The inclusion of maps, neatly printed adjacent to each species, readily gives the reader visual indication of where or where not to expect any particular bird. Breeding range, distinct from migration movements, is not denoted. Perhaps one can readily find that extension of the shaded portion is necessary in some instances, or that the area depicted is too excessive, but every author of such publications soon realises more than anyone the limitations in so many instances even amidst a mass of accumulated data. Mr Wheeler has summarised this carefully in stating: "Lists such as this one are made to be built on and if help already given is any criterion then further help should fill the gaps that must appear in such a publication.

Classification and nomenclature follow the 1926 Checklist, thus differing from such recent Handlists for South Australia. New South Wales. Western Australia and Northern Territory. However the author has explained the reasons for this. Even though a new Australian Checklist will become a reality in the near future, numbers included in this Victorian list can readily be adapted to it by cross reference. I would have preferred smaller dimensions, as a pocket-size list would have been particularly advantageous in the field. Nevertheless, I have no doubt that it will prove valuable to everyone interested in the observation, movements and range of Australian birds.

List of Northern Territory Birds, by G. M. Storr. Western Australian Museum Special Publication No. 4.

February 28, 1967, 90 pp.

This is a very informative publication, which covers the political limits of the Northern Territory, a Commonwealth Territory in which the status and range of birds has been perhaps least understood. The distribution of each species has been carefully detailed and will be invaluable to the Committee, of which Dr Storr is a member, preparing a new Australian Checklist. Under "Status, etc." all-important notes on the selected habitat-ecology are included. There is no map but Appendix 2 is a gazetteer of all place names.

Classification follows Peters Check List in the main except for the oscine families which is that recom-
