
# Brown Thornbill Acanthiza pusilla Species No.: 475 Band size: 01

# Ageing:

Adult (1+)	Immature/Juvenile (1)
black with pale cream base to lower mandible;	blackish grey with yellowish base to lower mandible;
black;	yellow fading to cream;
black;	yellow;
claret red or reddy-brown;	muddy brown;
boldly scalloped;	scalloping absent or faint;
heavily streaked;	clear buff with faint streaks;
olive fringes;	brownish fringes

#### Sexing:

Not size or plumage dimorphic.

Only females develop a brood patch. Though some immatures may develop large vascularised brood patches

### Similar species:

Very similar to Inland Thornbill *Acanthiza apicalis* and their ranges overlap in s-e SA, n-w Victoria west of the divide in NSW and s-e Qld. The species can be separated by differences in patterns of sub-terminal bands on rectrices as shown in the diagram below:




Figure 1. Rectrix (t6) variation between species and subspecies: (a) Brown Thornbill Acanthiza pusilla pusilla (b) A. pusilla dawsonensis (c) Inland Thornbill A. apicalis apicalis (sw. Aust. population) (d) A. apicalis albiventris (e) A. apicalis whitlocki
