

Little information on moult.

Second Immature is similar to adult female, but the top of the head of immatures is browner than adult female and underside barring is more diffuse.

Immatures also retain some juvenile rufous primaries, secondaries and secondary coverts, also retained greater primary coverts have a whitish or cream-buff tips.

Not known when adult plumage is attained. However, moult from juvenile to first immature occurs soon after fledging and there are at least two immature plumage moults post-breeding seasons. Accordingly, Immatures should be recorded as (2-) and adults (2+)

Sexing:

Plumage of adult male and female are hugely dimorphic.

Incubation by female only.
