

Ageing:

Juveniles, immatures and adults are readily distinguished by plumage and bare parts. Adult Male Adult Female Juvenile Bill: red – orange-red with small grey-black tip glossy grey-black; but appears to develop dark (dusky) colour in non-breeding season; Gape & tomia: as for bill; as for bill; light yellow --to salmon; Greater primary coverts - upper: green-blue outer edges; mostly violet; dark olive-brown; - lower: greenish-blue with grevish green-blue; grevish green-blue; dark blue tinge at tips; Remiges: outer edges violet; outer edges dark blue; glossy brownish-grey.

Immatures start to moult to adult plumage at about one year old. Thus Immatures aged (2-) and adults (2+).

Sexing :

Sexes dimorphic on plumage – see ageing above. Unknown whether female, male, or both incubate.
