## Ageing:

Fledge in distinctive brown mottled plumage. Moult to adult –like plumage within 3 months but immatures retain juvenile secondaries which are dark brown with light brown to off-white fringes. Moult to adult plumage commences at approximately one year old.

Thus immatures (2-) and adults (2+).

## Sexing:

Adult females differ from adult males only in ventral colouring:

- Male breast is rufous-brown grading to light rufous-brown on belly, flanks and undertail coverts;
- Female upper breast is light rufous-brown. Lower breast, belly and flanks off-white finely barred with grey;
