Ageing:

- Breeding recorded from July through February;
- Most juvenile body feathers are moulted within 3 months of fledging;
- Immature is mostly as adult but with retained dark brown juvenile alula, greater primary coverts, remiges and rectrices.
- Immatures best distinguished from adults by presence of brown tips to retained juvenile greater secondary coverts and rectrices are narrow and more pointed at tips than adult;
- Timing of moult to adult plumage not positive, but probably coincides with post-breeding moult of adults after the breeding season following fledging.
- Immatures will be either (1) or (2-) and adults (2+).

Sexing :

Not sexually dimorphic by plumage or measurements. Incubation by female only.
