


Tropical Scrubwren *Sericornis beccarii* Species No.: 490 Band Size: 01

Ageing :

Juveniles have greyish or brownish iris, whereas adults have a red eye.

Difficult to separate immatures and adults, but some juvenile remiges and rectrices may be retained in immatures.

Moult to adult plumage at approximately one year of age. So adults (1+), immatures (1).

Sexing

	Male	Female
Lower forehead:	black tinge;	tan-brown
Supraloral spot:	obvious;	diffuse;
Lores:	dark brown or black-brown;	cinnamon brown;
Supercillium stripe above lores & ear coverts:	off-white;	very diffuse or absent;

Males slightly larger than females, but overlap in all measurements makes sexing by this method unreliable.

Not known whether both sexes incubate.
