

Juvenile has distinctive plumage that differs from immatures and adults (see illustration); Immatures of both sexes have similar plumage to adults, but can be separated because they retain juvenile remiges and retrices and some upperwing coverts; Also, tip of Alula is rounded in Juveniles and immatures, but pointed in adults; Adult plumage is attained during the first year, so adults are aged (1+).
