

Ageing:

Moult to immature plumage commences immediately upon fledging;

First immatures retain juvenile remiges and rectrices and at least the outer 2-3 greater primary coverts and alula. Contrast between retained juvenile and adult feathers reliably ages immatures; Full adult plumage attained in moult early in second year, coinciding with adult post-breeding moult; Thus immatures (2-) and adults (2+).

Sexing:

Not sexually dimorphic on plumage, but males are much larger than females; Overlap in wing length and tail length will not positively sex all birds. Data on THL and/or wingspan may provide more reliable sexing criteria. Only female incubates.
