The Bird Banders' Association of Australia **Annual General Meeting**

The Ninth Annual General Meeting of the Association was held in the Hallstrom Theatre, The Australian Museum, Sydney, on Saturday 16 January 1971. The Chairman, Dr A. M. Gwynn was unavoidably delayed and Mr S. G. Lane who deputised pending his arrival, welcomed all present, particularly interstate and country members.

Dr F. H. Talbot, Director of the Museum, was then asked to officially open the meeting. In doing so, Dr Talbot said he was pleased that the Museum was able to assist natural history organisations such as this Association, even if only in a small way. He congratulated the Association on its excellent progress and hoped that this would continue. The acting chairman thanked Dr Talbot for his remarks and for his very helpful assistance and co-operation.

Mr Lane apologised for the absence of the President (Mrs Pauline Reilly) who had expressed her deep regret that she could not be present. Other apologies were received also.

Dr Gwynn then took over the chair and apologised for his unavoidable lateness.

The Chairman thanked the honorary auditors, Messrs G. T. Bush and M. T. Murn for their assistance. Mr Murn was re-appointed but as Mr Bush had asked to be relieved of this duty, the appointment of a second auditor was left to the Committee.

The Scientific Meeting followed the closing of the Annual Meeting. Mr Peter Balmford presented a very interesting resumé of the Penguin Survey being carried out by the Victorian Ornithological Research Group on Phillip Island, Victoria. Slides and photographs were used to show various aspects of the work, and maps to indicate recoveries and seasonal currents in the vicinity of Bass Strait.

Mr Roy Mackay spoke of birding and banding in New Guinea. He also used slides to indicate some of the difficulties of terrain and the problems associated with it. A few of the birds encountered were screened.

The speakers were thanked for their very interesting presentations.

The Australian Bird Bander volume 8, consisted of four parts totalling 96 pages to which 17 authors contributed three major and 12 short articles. There was in addition a four page index and a flyleaf for volume 7.

Recovery Round-up listed 233 items of 79 species including many longevity records and distant recoveries. The most interesting of these was a Sacred Kingfisher, banded near Mudgee, N.S.W. and caught in the Trobriand Islands off north-east New Guinea. "Bird in the Hand" described characters of 12 species from five families.

The Committee expresses its appreciation to those who assisted in various ways during the year.
