Gape:	black;	pale yellow changing with age;
Palate:	black;	deep yellow to grey & black with age;
Iris:	black-brown sometimes greyish tinge;	initially mid-brown changing to brown;
Ear patch:	black;	dark brown;

white – extending from base of upper Supercilium:

mandible to above ear patch with narrow black upper border;

Immatures may retain juvenile remiges and rectrices and can be distinguished from adults by wear of primaries and synchronous growth bars in the tail;

Full adult plumage is attained in the post-breeding season moult in the second year;

Thus immatures not showing juvenile features (yellow gape and palate etc.) should be aged (2-) and adults will be (2+).

## Sexing:

Reliable sexing is not possible on external examination, but males may have more black than females on ear coverts and lores.
