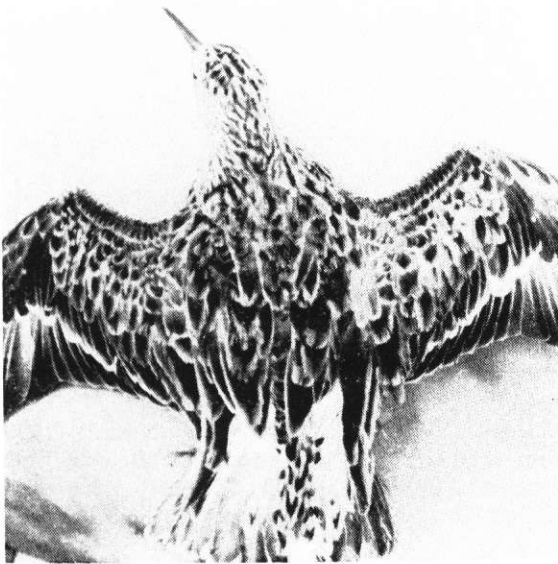


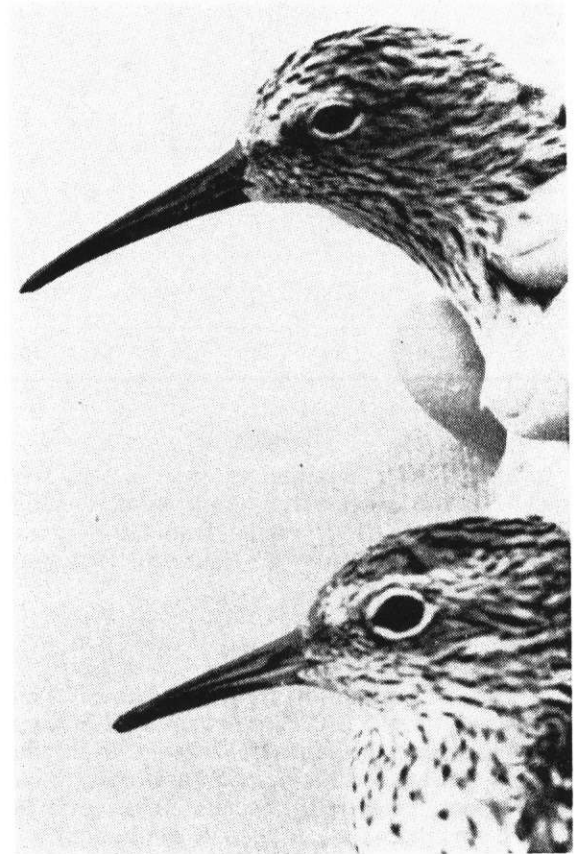
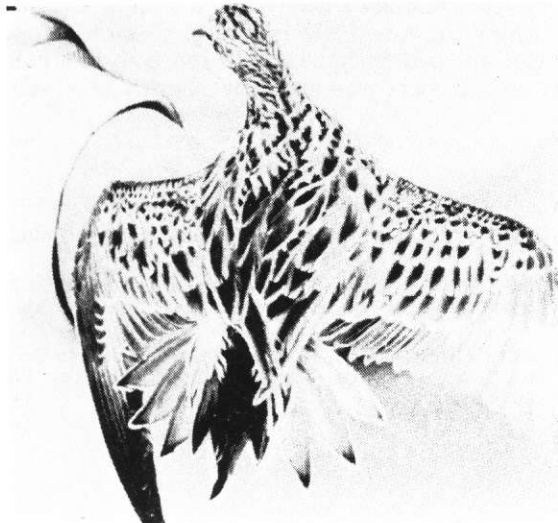
A Hybrid Wader?
