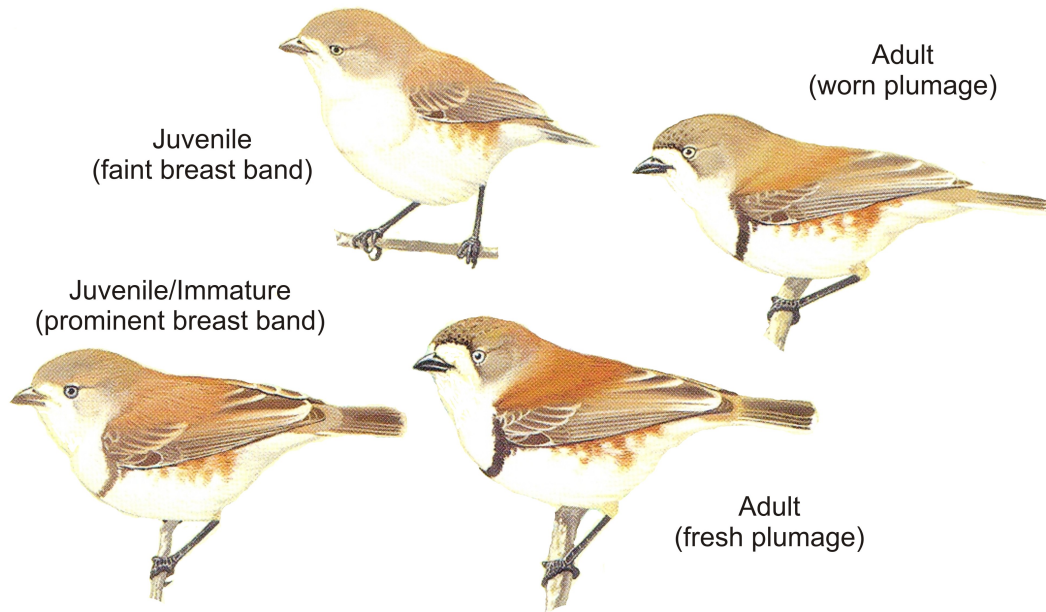


Banded Whiteface *Aphelocephala nigricincta* Species No.: 469 Band size: 01

Ageing:

	Adult (1+)	Juvenile
Bill:	black or grey-black, also described as brownish-black, brown or black with grey base to lower mandible;	brown;
Gape:	black or grey-black;	yellow;
Iris:	cream or white or creamy-white;	bluish-yellow or bluish-grey when recently fledged;
Forehead:	off-white or buff with blackish-brown lines above and bisecting the frons;	off-white to pale buff with no black above or bisecting the frons;
Other plumage:	see illustrations above	

Juvenile distinguished by plumage and bare parts;
 First immature very similar to adult and some are doubtfully identifiable;
 At least some immatures retain all juvenile remiges and rectrices – often identified by presence of synchronous growth-bars or fault-bars or both.

Sexing :

No difference in plumage or size;
 Not known whether both sexes brood.
