

Ageing:

Juvenile/Immature - bare skin behind eye is pale yellow to pale orange (see colour chart above); Immature - Plumage duller and fluffier than adults;

Adult - bare skin behind eye deep orange. (see colour chart above);

Alula is pointed in adults, but has a rounded tip in juveniles and immatures:

Adult plumage and bare skin colours are attained early in the second year, coinciding with adult post-breeding moult;\. Thus adults are aged (2+).

Sexing:

Indistinguishable by plumage;

Small overlap in sizes, but some adults can be separated because males are generally slightly larger than females. Best indicator - Adult Wing Length: M > 97 F < 97; Incubation by breeding female only – frequently fed at nest by mate and auxiliaries.
