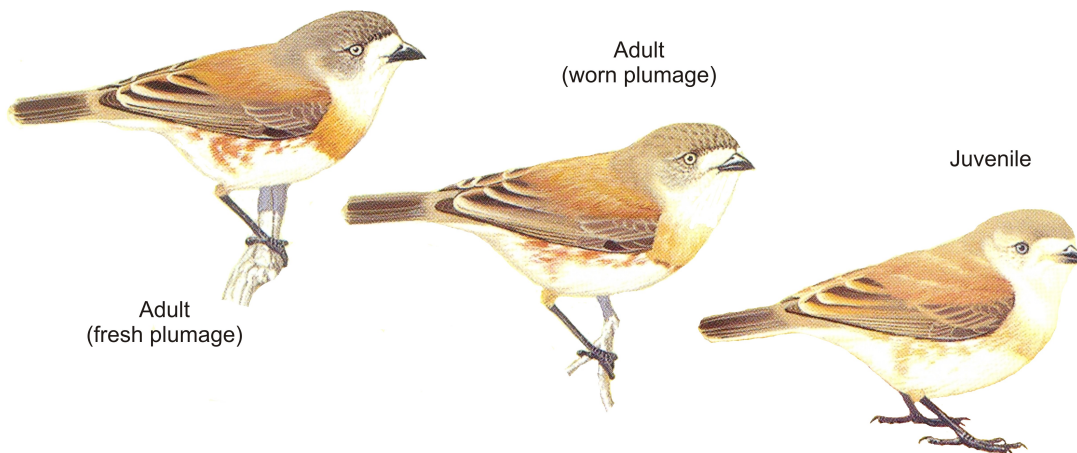


Chestnut-breasted Whiteface *Aphelocephala pectoralis* Species No.: 468 Band size:



Morphometrics:

	Adult Male	Adult Female
Wing:	55 -59 mm	52 – 59 mm
Tail:	38 – 41 mm	37 – 45 mm
Weight:	8.5 – 9.0 g	

Ageing:

	Adult (1+)	Juvenile
Bill:	black or grey-black;	grey-black with pinkish-brown base to lower mandible and upper tomium;
Gape:	black or grey-black;	dull pinkish or cream;
Iris:	cream, some with light blue tinge;	bluish-grey, distinctly darker than adult;
Forehead, lores, malar area, chin and throat:	white usually with cream tinge, with black-brown band across upper forehead;	off-white, lacks black-brown band across upper forehead;
Other plumage:	see illustrations above	

Juvenile distinguished by plumage and possibly bare parts;
 Immatures very similar to adults and difficult to distinguish;
 At least some immatures retain all juvenile remiges and rectrices – often identified by presence of synchronous growth-bars or fault-bars or both.

Sexing :

No difference in plumage or size;
 Not known whether both sexes brood.
