Bill: black; mid-brown often with darker tip;

Gape: black; pale yellow;

Forehead, crown & nape: light brownish-grey with fine light grey-brown, lacks streaking;

dark brown shaft streaks;

Mantle, scapulars & back: grey-brown; light brownish;

Breast, flanks & belly: uniform light brownish-grey, buffish-grey grading to richer buff

With some faint light in centre of belly;

brownish streaking;

Bill of immature is initially brownish-pink with darker base and gape yellow Immatures retain juvenile primaries, secondaries greater coverts and rectrices. Primaries and rectrices often have growth-bars.

## Sexing:

There is no sexual dimorphism in plumage, though males are slightly larger than females; THL measurements may be useful to separate sexes;

All females have wing length less than 81 mm, but only about half of males are greater than 81mm; Both sexes incubate.
