

Bill:

Juvenile / Immature

brown or purple-horn with base of
tip to upper mandible and paler

lower mandible usually yellow

base to lower mandible;

Gape: dark blue-grey; yellow;

Bare skin under eye: blue – smaller than adult male; yellow;

Iris: dark red-brown; pale hazel or brownish;
Coverts: dark brown with off-white to light fringes are buff and broader than

fringes; adult female;

Alula tip: both adults – pointed; rounded

General plumage: see illustrations above; browner than adult female;

Adult male bare parts are similar to adult female, but plumage is very different – see illustrations; It is not known when moult to adult plumage occurs so age all first-capture birds (1+).

Sexing:

Not size dimorphic;

Adult male is pied black and white;

Female basically brown above and white below, but breast has dark brown tear-shaped spots; Both male and female develop brood patches.
