

Immatures are very similar to adults but retain juvenile remiges, rectrices and greater primary coverts. Retained juvenile plumage is readily identified as more worn than other plumage.

## Sexing:

Sexes can be separated on size (THL & wing length); Males are said to be more richly coloured than females, with whiter bellies and more intense rufous uppertail and undertail coverts and flanks - but difficult to prove; Only females develop a brood patch.
