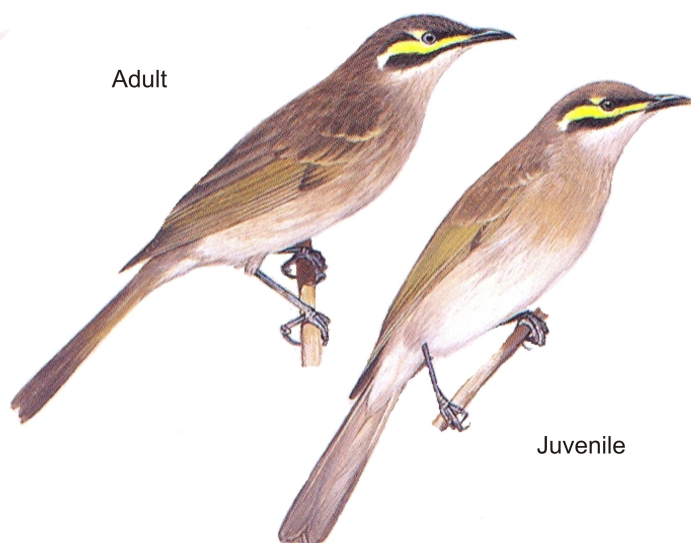


**Yellow-faced Honeyeater** *Lichenostomus chrysops* Species No.: 614 Band Size: 02

**Ageing:**

	Adult (2+)	Immature (2-)	Juvenile
Bill:	black;	black with brown nasal groove;	grey-black, with brown or orange tip;
Gape:	off-white, or cream;	yellow;	pinkish or yellow;
Eye:	dusky blue;	brown inner ring, bluish outer ring;	brown;
Forehead, crown & nape:	brownish-grey;	similar to adult;	uniform greyish-brown;
Chin and upper throat:	off white;	similar to adult;	off white with light brown tinge;
Lower throat:	light grey;	similar to adult;	uniform brown;
Rump & upper tail coverts & rectrices:	dark brown grading to light brown on outer feathers;	retain most feathers of juvenile;	light brown;
Alula tip:	pointed;	rounded;	rounded;

Immatures can be identified into their second Spring. So age immatures as (2-) or (1) depending on the condition of retained juvenile plumage and time of year. Full adult plumage is attained midway through the second year, so adults will be aged (2+).

**Sexing :**

Sexually dimorphic only on size with males larger than females;  
Only the female incubates.
