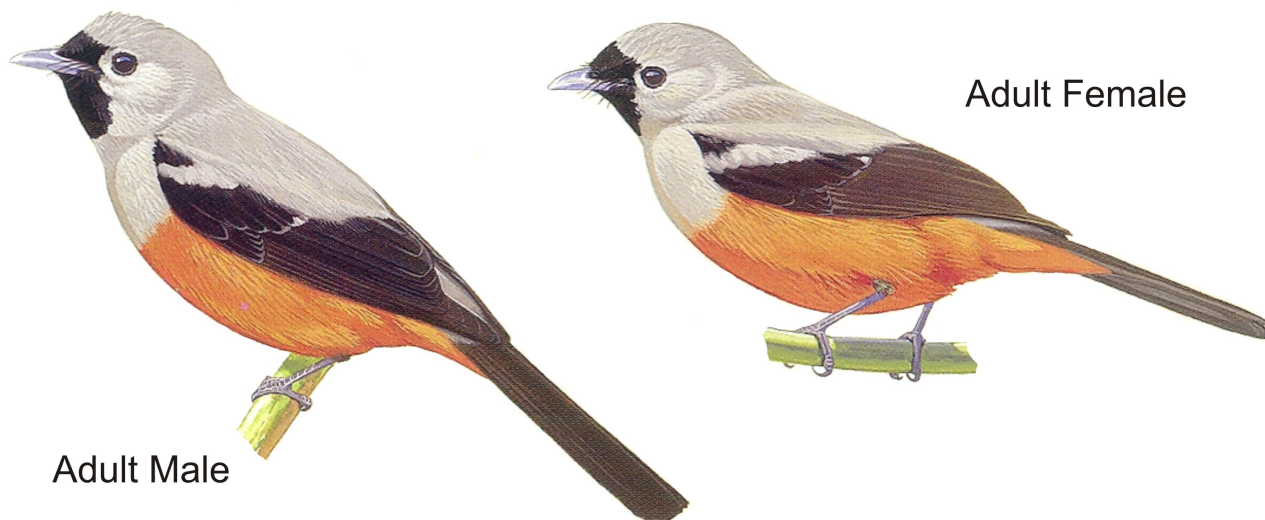


Black-winged Monarch *Monarcha frater*

Ageing:

Very little information available;

In Australia, this species occurs only in a small region of eastern Cape York Peninsular, Queensland and Torres Strait islands. It is thought to migrate to New Guinea for Winter;

There is no information on the Juvenile plumage;

Immature is said to be similar to the adult without black facial mask;

Except for obviously just fledged juveniles (J), all birds should thus be aged as (1+).

Sexing :

Adults are plumage dimorphic with the male having a considerably larger black facial mask and bib than the female;

It is not known whether both sexes incubate.
