

Ageing:

Adult (1+) **Immature** Juvenile Bill: pale bluish or bluish mauve with dark grey pinkish-brown or dirty pink -grey with black tip; coloured with black tip; tip; bright yellow; Gape: black; whitish; Iris: dark red-brown to olive brown; olive brown;

chocolate brown;

Juveniles easily distinguished from Immatures and Adults – see illustrations;

Immatures retain all juvenile remiges, greater coverts, rectrices and feathers of alula – see tail feather illustration above;

Immatures probably commence moult to adult-like plumage when approximately six months old, coinciding with adults undergoing their complete post-breeding moult; Immatures are thus aged (1) and adults (1+);

Sexing:

Sexes not size or plumage dimorphic; Incubation by both sexes.
