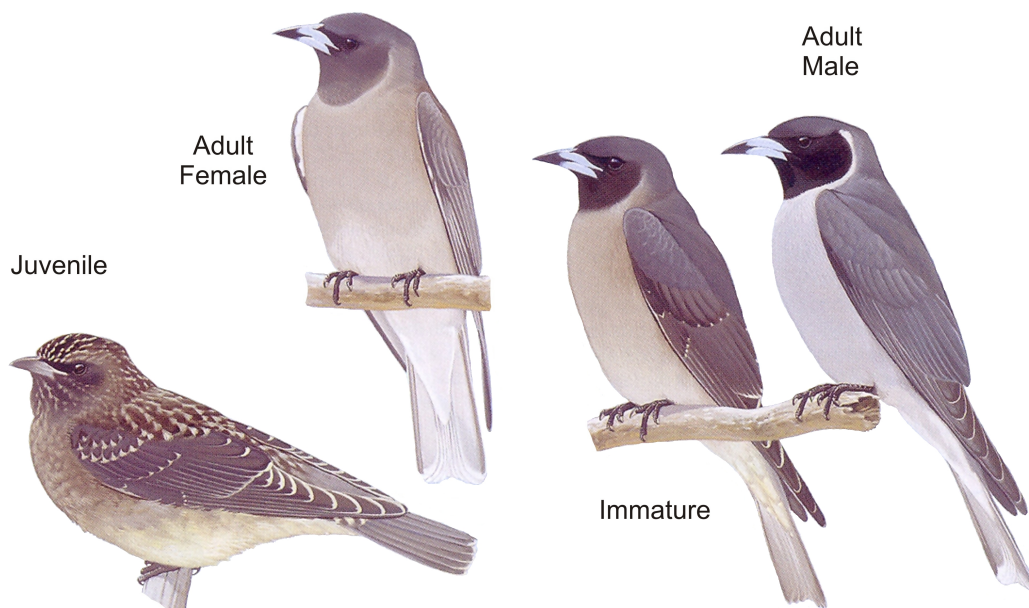


Masked Woodswallow *Atrtamus personatus*

Ageing:

	Adult (2+)	Immature (1) or (2-)	Juvenile (J)
Bill:	bluish-grey or pale blue with black distal third or half;	similar to adult;	brown with faint black tip;
Gape:	bluish-grey or light grey	no info;	pale yellowish or flesh coloured;
Iris:	dark brown, brown or hazel; no info;		greenish-yellow;

Immatures retain most juvenile remiges, greater coverts, rectrices and feathers of alula;
 Immatures probably commence moult to adult-like plumage when approximately six months old, coinciding with adults undergoing their complete post-breeding moult and attain full adult plumage at approximately 1 year old;
 Immatures are thus aged (2-) or (1) based on time of year and plumage wear and adults (2+);
 Immature males have a darker head, back and wings than adult females.

Sexing :

Adults and Immatures can be sexed on plumage characters;

	Adult Male	Immature Male	Adult & Immature Female
Forehead:	grey-black or dark grey, usually black on lower sides of forehead;	grey black;	dark grey grading to dark brownish at sides;
Crown, nape & neck:	bluish-grey or grey, grading to white or greyish-white on anterior sides of neck;	dark grey;	dark grey, paler and less bluish than adult male;
Mask:	black with whitish band curving below & behind mask;	brownish dark grey -brown band below and behind mask;	dark grey/grey & narrow light grey-brown band below and behind mask;
Breast & belly:	pale grey or whitish-grey;	light brown;	greyish-brown with pinkish-brown tinge.
