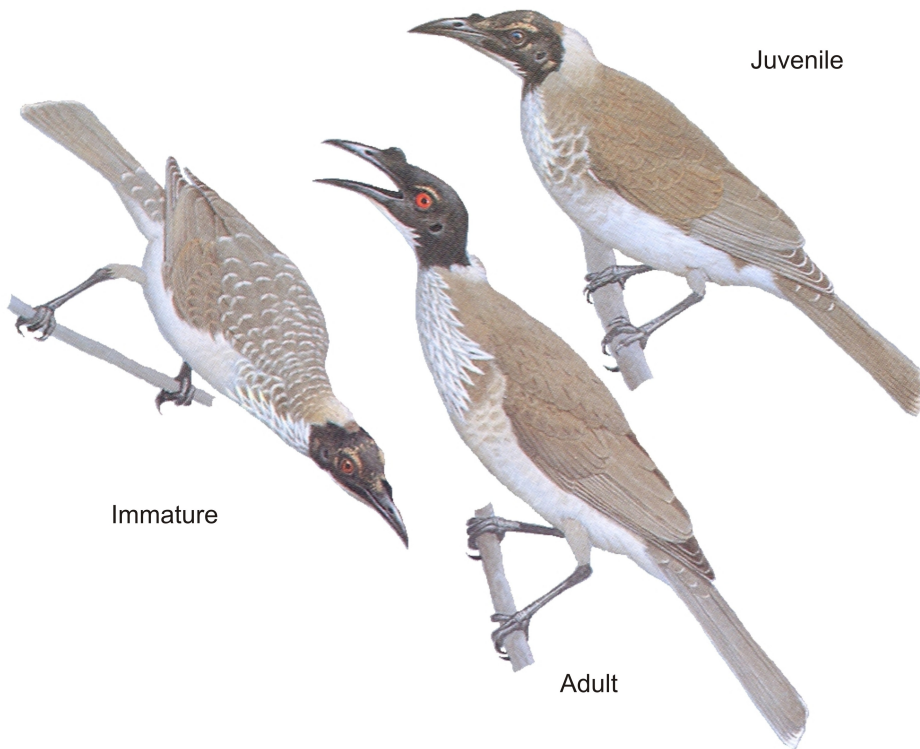


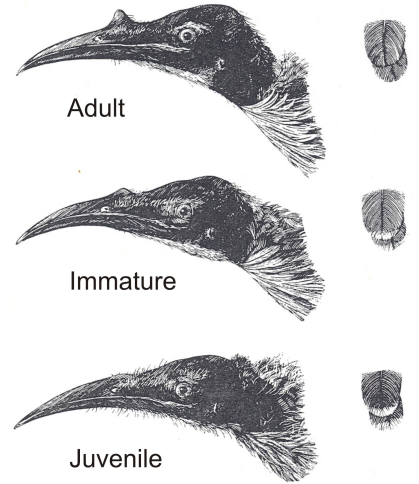

Ageing:

	Adult	Immature	Juvenile
Iris:	red, crimson or red-brown;	brownish-red or khaki with thin inner red ring	grey with red-brown inner ring;
Forehead/lores:	bare;	buff feathers;	well feathered;
Nape:	bare/few feathers;	often bare;	well feathers;
Casque:	well defined;	small;	small and flattened;
Upper breast:	feathers elongate, tipped white;	feathers elongate, tipped lemon;	feathers short, distal one-third edged lemon;
Back/rump:	feathers mid-grey, fringed silvery-grey, often with darker central shafts;	feathers light brown, broadly fringed white;	rump buff to grey-brown; upper tail coverts and feathers of back broadly fringed white;
Alula:	tip pointed;	tip rounded;	tip rounded.

Adult (3+ Spring 2+ Autumn): Knob on bill – conspicuous;
 Immatures: (2-): Knob on bill – conspicuous but smaller than adult;
 Juvenile: (1): Knob on bill is inconspicuous;

Sexing :

Plumage of both sexes appears identical, but sexually dimorphic on measurements;
 Only female incubates.
