Juveniles lack black streaks on lores and ear coverts and lack the dark brown to black-brown submoustachial stripe of adults;

Immatures retain juvenile remiges rectrices which may show synchronous growth bars; Immatures attain adult plumage when approximately one year old, probably coinciding with adult post-breeding moult. Thus immatures will be either (1) or (2) and adults will be (2+).

Sexing:

Adults are sexually dimorphic on plumage: adult females have a distinct rufous-brown flanks, whereas this is absent in adult males;

Not known whether both sexes incubate.
