Juveniles lack black streaks on lores and ear coverts and lack the dark brown to black-brown submoustachial stripe of adults ;

Immatures retain juvenile remiges rectrices which may show synchronous growth bars; Immatures attain adult plumage when approximately one year old, probably coinciding with adult post-breeding moult. Thus immatures will be either (1) or (2) and adults will be (2+).
