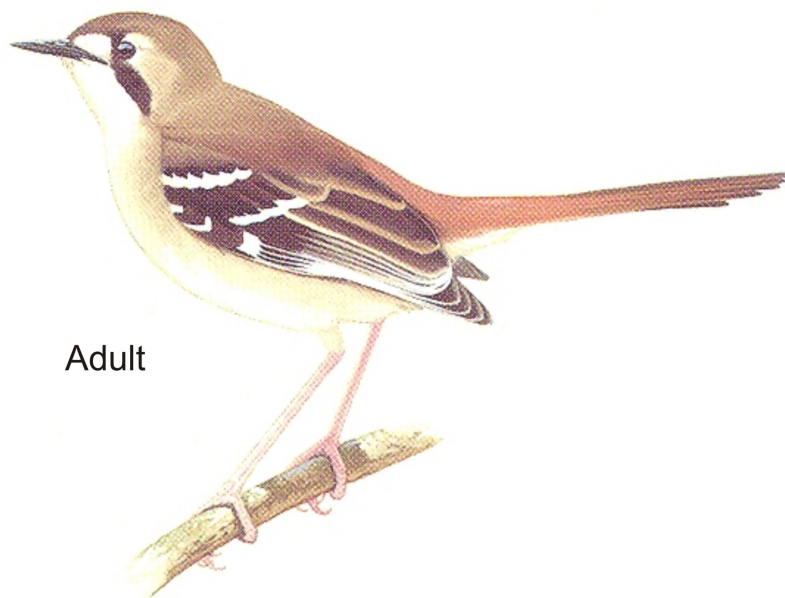


**Northern Scrub-robin** *Drymodes superciliaris*      **Species No.: 442**      **Band size: 04**



Adult

Morphometrics:

	Adult Male	Adult Female
Wing:	103 – 109 mm	105 – 106 mm
Tail:	96 – 106 mm	96 -97 mm
Weight:	42 – 46 g	

Ageing:

This species is poorly known and there is little information on ageing;  
There are no skins in museums and the juvenile has not been described;  
Based on a single first immature specimen that had retained juvenile plumage of wing and tail, the juvenile has a slight rufous suffusion to tips of rectrices and to most feathers of the wing;  
Immatures are similar to adults but retain juvenile rectrices which are similar to adults, but narrower and slightly more pointed tips;  
Immatures are thought to start to moult to adult plumage when about one year old coinciding with adult post-breeding moult;  
Thus Immatures are either (2-) or (1) depending on time of year and condition of retained juvenile plumage and adults will be aged (1+);

Sexing:

Not plumage dimorphic and both sexes incubate;  
Some males may be slightly larger than females, but there is insufficient data to confirm this.
