Ageing:

	Adult (1+)	Juvenile
Bill:	mostly light blue-grey with off-white tomia;	dark grey;
Iris:	black-brown; dark brown or greyish-brown;	dark brown;
Head:	whitish-grey, or off-white;	brown or light brown;
Rump:	yellow-brown;	light brown;

Complete post-juvenile moult to adult plumage within 5 months of fledging. So apart from obvious Juveniles (J) age all birds (1+).

Sexing :

Sexes very similar, but some claim that females have slightly paler underparts and a greyer, less silvery, appearance on the crown than males;
Both sexes incubate.
