Juvenile attains first immature plumage at about 6 months, but retains grey-brown juvenile remiges and rectrices, alula and primary coverts;

Adult plumage is achieved early in second year coinciding with adult post-breeding moult in second summer. Thus immatures (2-) or (1) and adults (2+).

Sexing :

Not sexually dimorphic in measurements or plumage, though males average larger than females It is thought that female does all incubation.
