


Rockwarbler *Origma solitaria*

| Forehead, crown, nape & hindneck: | tan-brown with blackish-brown scalloping to dark brownish-grey or olive-brown with indistinct tan-brown tinge; | slightly paler than adult and has pale rufous-brown tinge; |
| Malar area, chin & throat: | off-white with dark brown barring, or mottling; | light greyish with tan-brown tinge and faint dark brown barring on chin; |
| Upper breast: | rufous-brown, with strong contrast between throat and upper breast; | pale tan-brown, with indistinct contrast with throat colour; |
| Breast, belly & flanks: | rufous-brown to tan-brown; | pale tan-brown. |

Full adult plumage probably attained at about one year of age. Based on the above data, adults can only be aged as (1+).

Sexing :

Not sexually dimorphic on size or plumage;
Not known whether both sexes brood.
