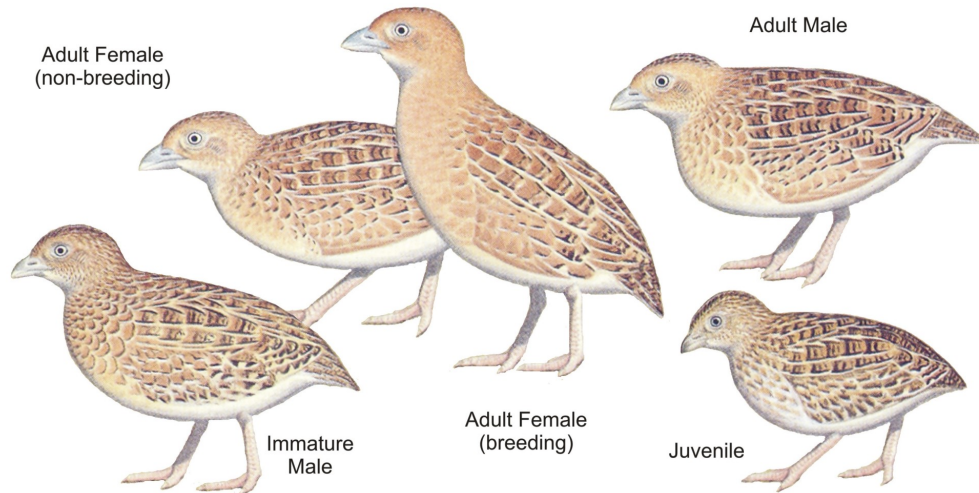


Little Button-quail *Turnix velox* Species No.: 18 Band size: 04 AY

Ageing & Sexing:

	Adult Male (1+)	Adult Female (1+)	Juvenile
Head & neck:	breeding – nape & top of head rufous-brown mottled by black-brown; non-breeding – similar to breeding plumage;	breeding - top of head & nape fairly uniform rufous brown to light rufous-crown; non-breeding – similar to male but with white crown stripe;	similar to adult male but feathers smaller & narrower;
Upperparts:	breeding & non-breeding - rufous brown finely & irregularly barred black-brown & boldly streaked white;	breeding – black barring less extensive than male; non-breeding – same as male;	similar to male but lacks buff freckling at distal ends of feathers;
Upper breast & foreneck:	breeding - buff scalloped light rufous-brown; non-breeding – brown scalloping more distinct;	breeding – black barring less distinct than male;	white breast coarsely streaked dark grey-brown;
Upperwing:	dark barring;	black barring less extensive than male;	as adult male.

Incubation by male only, starting when the clutch is complete.
