
White-browed Scrubwren Sericornis frontalis Species No.: 488 Band Size: 02



Morphometrics:

There are ten recognised subspecies of the White-browed Scrubwren and seven of those are illustrated above. There is very little variation in the measurements between the subspecies, but those for *S.f. frontalis* are given here as a sample:

THL: 32.3 – 35.1 mm Wing: 54 – 62 mm Tail: 45 – 53 mm Weight: 11.0 – 14.5 q

Ageing:

The flowing diagnostic characters apply equally to all subspecies:

Adult (1+) Immature/Juvenile (1)

Bill: black; grey;

Gape: pale brown; grey-black; Eve: cream dull grey; Evebrow & moustachial stripe: indistinct: prominent: Shoulder flash: distinct white; indistinct; Coverts: brown; buff: Feet & legs: pinkish grey; pink

Sexing Sexually dimorphic plumage and males may be slightly larger than females.

Males – black lores and some also black behind the eye between eyebrow and moustacial stripes.

Females – grey to brown lores and behind eye.

Incubation by female only.
