Morphometrics:

The Dusky Robin is restricted to Tasmania and its islands. The measurements presented here are for the nominate *M.v. vittata*, but the subspecies *M.v. kingi* of King Island is virtually identical.

Ageing:

See illustrations above:

Juveniles moult to adult-like immature plumage within a few months of fledging;

Immatures can be separated from adults by retained juvenile greater and secondary coverts, alula, remiges and rectrices;

Retained juvenile secondary coverts have diffuse off-white to white rosethorns at tips, whereas adults have a narrow white fringe to the tips of secondary coverts;

Moult to complete adult plumage commences late in the first year, thus adults are aged (2+).

Sexing:

There is no sexual dimorphism in size or plumage; Incubation is by the female only.
