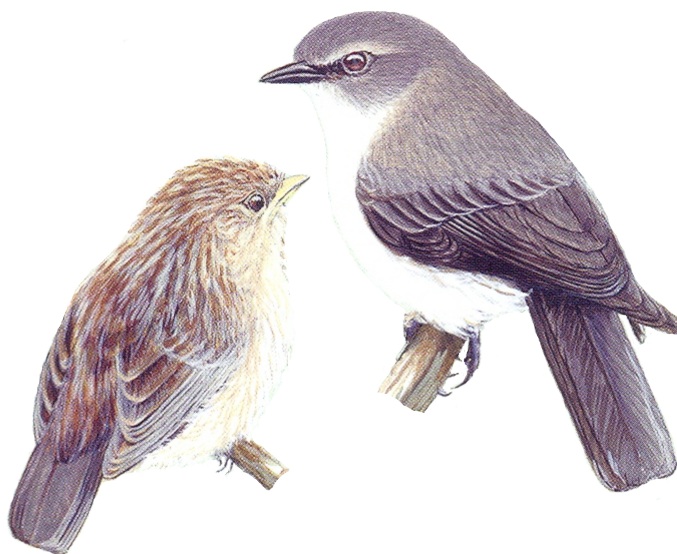


White-breasted Robin *Eopsaltria georgiana* **Species No.: 387** **Band size: 02**



Morphometrics:

Wing:	70 – 83 mm	70 – 79 mm
Tail:	61 – 73 mm	60 – 67.5 mm

Ageing:

- Most juvenile body feathers are moulted within 3 months of fledging;
- First immature is mostly as adult but with retained dark brown juvenile alula, greater primary coverts, remiges and rectrices. Retained tertials and secondaries have noticeable buff or light-brown suffusion to tips;
- First Immature best distinguished from adults by off-white to light grey-brown rosethorns to tips of greater secondary coverts;
- Moults to adult plumage completed in second Summer coinciding with adult post-breeding season moult;
- Immatures are therefore either (1) or (2-);
- Adults are (2+).

Sexing:

Males marginally larger than females;
Not sexually dimorphic in plumage;
Incubation by female only.
