Ageing:

Fledge in mottled pale grey plumage and undergo a partial post juvenile moult soon after fledging; Immatures retain all juvenile rectrices with distinct off-white or buff-white fringes at tips which are also more pointed than adults, all remiges, greater primary coverts and alula;

Probably acquire Adult plumage in post-breeding moult early in the second year, so age Immatures (2-) and Adults (2+).

Obvious differences in plumage of adults and immatures is as follows:

Head & neck: blue-grey with black or dark grey pale grey with little or no bluish tone & lores: fine dark-brown feather shaft streaks;

Sexing:

There is no apparent sexual dimorphism in plumage or size; Both sexes incubate.
