

Ground Cuckoo-Shrike *Coracina maxima* **Species No.: 423** **Band size: 07**

Ageing:

Bill:	black or grey-black, paler grey at base;	blackish with dull pink tomtia and base;
Iris:	pale yellow or yellow-white;	brown to yellowish-brown;
Upper back:	light grey;	pale greyish-cream with remnants of juvenile bold dark-brown barring;
Remiges & rectrices:	black;	blackish-brown;

Juvenile moults to immature plumage soon after fledging (see illustrations above).; Immature retains blackish-brown juvenile primaries, secondaries, alula, greater primary coverts and a varying number of rectrices, tertials and outer greater and median secondary coverts; Molt to adult plumage is thought to commence at about one year of age coinciding with adult post-breeding moult. Thus adults (2+).

Sexing :

Little information, but it appears that there is no sexual dimorphism in plumage or size; It is thought that adults share incubation.
