
Varied Triller Lalage leucomela Species No.: 431 Band size: 03



Ssp. L.I. rufiventris (NT)

Morphometrics:

Four subspecies in Australia – the three illustrated above and *L.I. macrura* of the Kimberley Div. WA. The following measurements are for *L.I. leucomela*. but all subspecies are similar in size.

Ageing:

Adults (2+) Immature (2-) Juvenile Bill: black; black; brownish;

Juveniles moult to an immature plumage soon after fledging;

Immatures of both sexes are "brown" and retain all juvenile secondaries, primaries, greater primary coverts, alula and a varying number of juvenile outer greater secondary upperwing coverts, all or some juvenile tertials and rectrices;

Immatures are readily distinguished from adult females by white fringes to tips of retained juvenile greater primary coverts and alula – white tips are absent in adult females; Immatures commence moult to adult plumage when about one year old.

Sexing:

The illustrations tell it all with respect to sexing and ageing by plumage; Adult males are marginally larger than adult females; Both sexes incubate.
