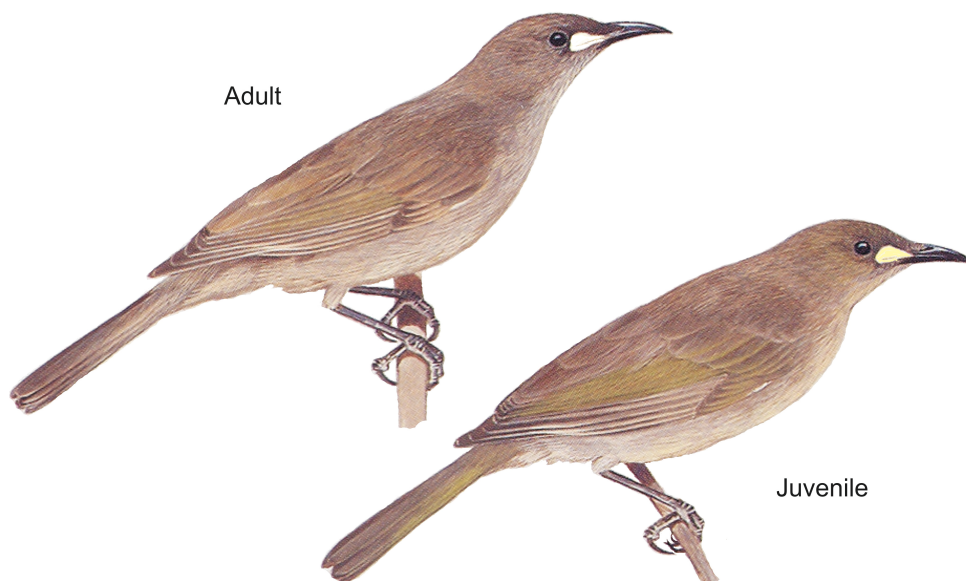


White-gaped Honeyeater *Lichenostomus unicolor* Species No.: 628 Band size: 03

Ageing:

	Adult (2+)	Juvenile
Bill:	black, brownish-black, brownish or grey-brown;	black with olive tip;
Gape & fleshy extension of gape:	white, cream, or pale yellow;	canary yellow, yellow or yellowish-cream;
Orbital ring:	dull reddish-brown or purplish-grey;	reddish;
Forehead, crown & nape:	olive-brown or greyish-olive with pale olive-brown or greyish-brown hindneck;	grey-olive with light brownish tinge to hindneck;
Chin & throat:	light grey with yellow-olive suffusion;	yellow-olive;
Alula tip:	pointed;	rounded;

Juvenile readily distinguished by plumage;

Immatures difficult to distinguish from adults, but some retain longest feather of alula, juvenile remiges and rectrices;

Immatures commence moult to complete adult plumage when approximately 1 year old coinciding with adult post breeding moult. Adults should thus be aged (2+).

Sexing :

No sexual dimorphism in plumage;

Most males are larger than females;

Incubation by female only.
