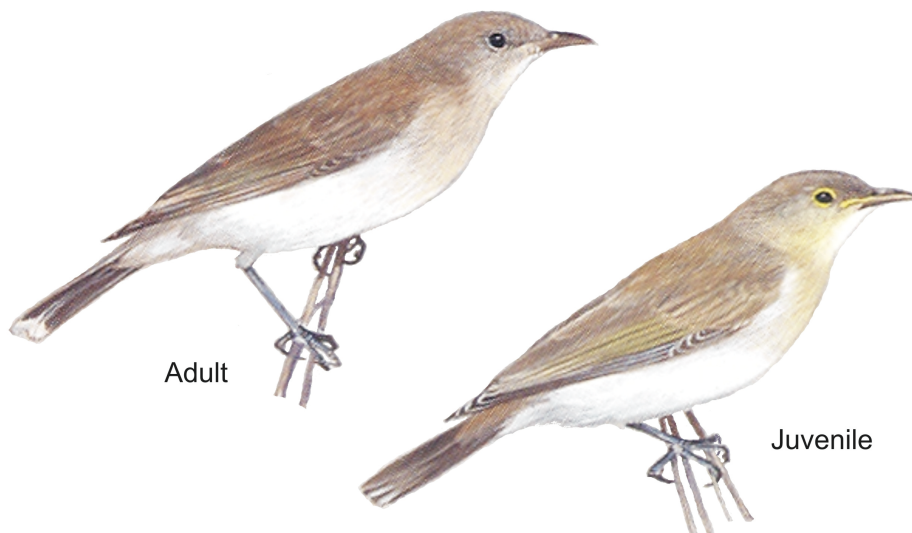


Grey Honeyeater *Conopophila whitei* Species No.: 599 Band size: 01

Wing:	60 – 66 mm	60 – 65 mm
Tail:	41 – 47 mm	39 – 46 mm
Weight:	7.0 – 10.3 g	9.4 – 11.0 g

Ageing:

	Adult (1+)	Juvenile
Bill:	grey with pinkish-brown base to lower mandible also described as black, brown with paler brown base to lower mandible;	greyish with pinkish-brown base to lower mandible;
Tomia:	greyish grading to pinkish-brown base;	yellowish;
Gape:	greyish;	orange-yellow, light orange or yellow;
Iris:	brown, red-brown or dark brown;	dark or dark horn;
Cheeks & ear coverts:	light grey-brown;	straw-yellow;
Eye ring:	grey-brown;	pale yellow or off-white;
Breast:	light grey-brown or off-white;	upper breast buff grading to off-white on lower breast;

Juveniles undergo a complete moult to immature plumage that is indistinguishable from adult plumage soon after fledging;

Adult plumage is also acquired in the first year, so all birds that are not in juvenile plumage should be aged (1+).

Sexing:

Sexes are alike in plumage and measurements;
Both sexes incubate;
