

ear coverts, lores & face:

Upperparts: mostly iridescent olive-green; olive with only slight iridescence; underparts: white with dark brown barring; mainly white grading to pale greyish brown and lacks barring;

Moult soon after fledging from juvenile plumage to an immature plumage possibly indistinguishable from adults,. Thus all except juveniles should be aged (1+).

Sexing:

Some adult males are larger than females but sexually dimorphic on characters listed below:
