	Adult (1+)	Juvenile
Bill:	black;	dark-grey to black;
Gape:	yellowish-white or pale yellow;	yellow;
Iris:	blue-grey or dark blue-grey;	light grey or grey;
Forehead:	olive grey;	plain brown;
Crown, nape & hindneck:	grey brown with distinct dark brown shaft streaks;	brown and lacking shaft streaks;
Chin & throat:	olive-brown with distinct yellow fringes to feathers producing finely scalloped or barred appearance;	pale yellow grading to brownish grey and not scalloped or barred;

Juveniles moult soon after fledging to an immature adult-like plumage, but retain some juvenile feathers;

Probably moults to adult plumage during the first Summer / Autumn. Thus all birds that are not identified as juvenile should be aged as (1+).

Sexing:

There is no dimorphism in plumage, but adult males average larger than adult females in wing length;
