Juveniles undergo a partial moult to immature plumage soon after fledging;

Immatures retain juvenile remiges and rectrices that are narrower and more acute than adults; Moult to adult plumage commences at about one year old, coinciding with post-breeding moult of adults. Thus adults are aged (2+);

Black palate colour in at least some males is not fully attained until after fourth year (see "Palate" under ageing above), so age males with a black palate (4+).

## Sexing:

No difference between the sexes in size or plumage, but the adults differ in the colour of the mouth

- adult males (4+) have a mostly black palate with a whitish distal half;
- \_ adult females (2+) have a yellowish to pinkish-flesh palate;

Incubation probably by female alone, but confirmation required.
