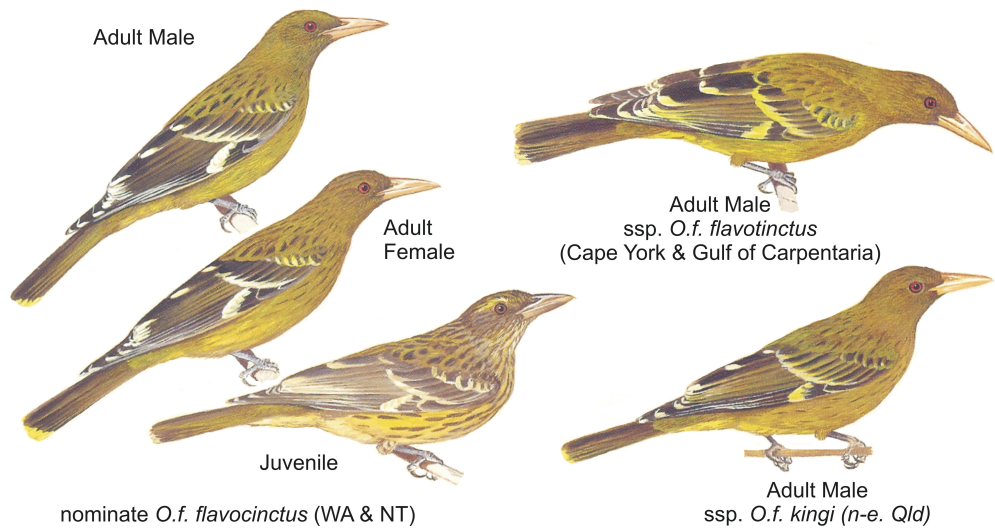


Yellow Oriole *Oriolus flavocinctus* Species No.: 672 Band size: 06



Morphometrics:

Three subspecies very similar in size. Data presented here are for nominate *O.f. flavocinctus*:

Wing:	140.0 – 149.5 mm	135.0 – 146.5 mm
Tail:	97.5 – 111.5 mm	137.0 – 148.0 mm
Weight:	83.0 – 100.0 g	73.0 – 88.0 g

Ageing and Sexing:

	Adult (3+)	Sub-adult (2)	First Immature (1)	Juvenile (J)
Bill:	dull pinkish to pinkish-brown or orange-rufous;	dull brown with dull reddish tinge;	black or dull brown-grey, dark horn or blackish brown;	dull brown;
Iris:	red;	reddish with age;	grey-brown, dark brown, red-brown, or light yellow;	blackish-grey or dark brown;
Head & neck:	yellowish-olive with blackish streaks on crown;	yellowish-olive with black-brown streaks on top of head;	yellowish olive with bold blackish-brown streaking on crown;	greyish-olive with dark brown shaft streaks on top of head & lores;
Supercilium:	diffuse faint yellow;	indistinct pale yellow;	distinct pale yellow;	distinct narrow yellow
Upperparts:	male – yellowish olive with bold streaks than male; -shaped streaks;	probably similar to adult female	entirely olive or dull bold blackish-brown mottling;	mantle & scapulars to yellow-olive on back;
Breast, flanks & belly:	male – yellowish-olive with fine blackish streaks; female – duller olive & more yellow than male & more heavily streaked;	as for adults but less streaking;	yellow or pale yellow grading to yellow-olive on flanks with bold blackish-brown streaking on breast, grading to fine on flanks & belly;	pale yellowish with bold dark olive-brown streaking;

Adult males are slightly larger than adult females and subtle differences in plumage (see above);
No information on incubation.
