


**Yellow-tinted Honeyeater** *Lichenostomus flavescens* Species No.: 624 Band size: 02

Ageing:

	Adult (1+)	Juvenile
Bill:	black;	yellow or brown with black tip, but becomes all black within the first year;
Gape:	grey or black;	yellow;
Iris:	dark brown, red-brown, olive-brown or grey-brown;	grey or dark brown;
Forehead & forecrown:	yellow-olive;	pale yellowish olive;
Hindcrown & nape:	light grey-brown or olive-grey with yellowish-olive suffusion;	light grey-brown with faint olive tinge;
Breast:	pale yellow with diffuse light grey-brown streaking;	off-white with pale yellow suffusion;
Alula tip:	pointed;	rounded;

Juveniles undergo a partial moult to immature plumage that basically resembles adult plumage soon after fledging, but immatures may retain some or all juvenile alula and primaries; Presence of synchronous growth or fault bars in the tail indicate retained juvenile feathers – thus immature aged (1);

Adult plumage is acquired in the first year, so all adult plumaged birds through the breeding season (late Winter to early Summer) are aged (2+), otherwise (1+);

Sexing :

No sexual dimorphism in plumage, but males larger than females (see THL and wing length above); Not known whether both sexes incubate.
