Adult (2+) Juvenile

Bill: dark grey on upper mandible and tip brown upper mandible and horn lower

of lower mandible, pale greyish, mandible;

pinkish-brown, or pale pinkish-grey

on basal two-thirds of lower mandible

and tomia;

Iris: dark brown; brown;

Forehead dark red-brown or rufous-brown dull russet-brown

& crown:

Mantle: brown or dark reddish-brown with dark brown;

rufous tinge:

Remiges: brown or dark brown with rufous tinge; dark brown;

Extent of post-juvenile moult within a few months of fledging is not fully understood, but probably only partial resulting in adult-like first immature plumage;

Immatures probably retain all remiges, rectrices and outer greater secondary coverts. Immatures are expected to have distinct synchronous fault bars at least to primaries;

Probably acquire complete adult plumage in moult commencing at about one year of age. Thus adults should be aged (2+).

## Sexing:

There is no sexual dimorphism in size or plumage;

There is no information on the role of the sexes in incubation.
