
Budgerigar Melanopsittacus undulatus Species No.: 310 Band size: 04 Incoloy



Morphometrics:

Tail: 87 - 112 mm 85 - 98 mm
Weight: 19 - 30 g 12 - 40 g

Ageing:

Adult (1+) Juvenile/immature

Bill: light brown-grey or yellow-brown; upper mandible variable pink-brown,

pale green, or dark brown and lower

mandible;

Cere: male - dark blue; purplish-white;

female - varies in colour from pink-brown when breeding to light blue when not

breeding;

Iris: white, yellow-white or cream; grey-black;

Forehead: pale yellow, unbarred; juvenile (J) – straw yellow, fully barred;

Immature (1) – straw yellow, mottled;

Cheeks: three dark violet spots; irregular violet blotches;

Post-juvenile moult to adult-like immature plumage commences about 7 weeks after fledging and then moult to adult plumage when 3 – 4 months old.

Sexing:

Adult are similar in plumage but sexes differ in cere colour as described above; Incubation by female alone.
