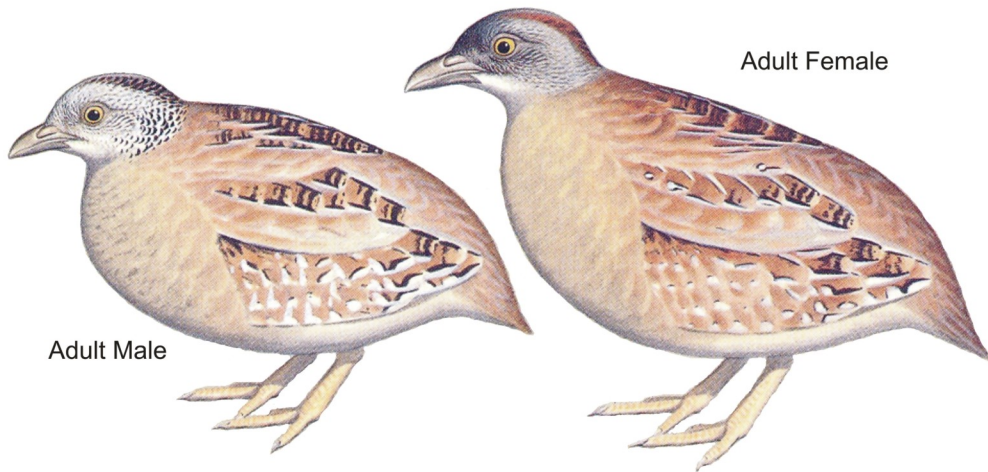


Buff-breasted Button-quail *Turnix olivei* **Species No.: 16** **Band size: Trial AY**

Ageing & sexing:

Females are considerably larger than males.

Very few skins of this species have been collected and they did not represent examples from throughout the year or from across the full distribution range of the species.

Accordingly, there is very little information available to reliably describe the array of plumage difference between the sexes and ages.

Because of lack of data, all birds should be aged (1+)
